

Who We Are

Orchard Club South is a non profit founded by a group of recovering individuals who saw a need for a facility in the Denver Tech Center area where people could gather to experience recovery.

While the traditional church basement is a great venue for recovery meetings, the need for a gathering place that allows for continued fellowship was missing.

After an extensive search, the current location was leased and renovated in 2009. A board of directors oversees the operations of the club, Including management of the club manager and oversight of all club finances and activities.

What We Do

Orchard Club South provides the following services:

- Four meeting rooms designed to accommodate 2-120 people
- Coffee bar manned by volunteers serving coffee and other drinks and snacks for meeting attendees.
- Literature availablefor purchase
- Anniversary chips for those celebrating milestones in recovery
- Pot Luck parties on major holidays throughout the year.
- Facility rental for district or state wide events

What We Don't Do

Any program of recovery utilizing the twelve step approach is welcome to hold meetings at the Orchard Club on a space available basis and with board approval. Meetings are completely self governed. Orchard Club has no say in:

These fees fund facility rental, the club manager, snack bar, anniversary chips, and access to program literature. From the group collection, 10% is returned to the group to use for group determined dispersements.
